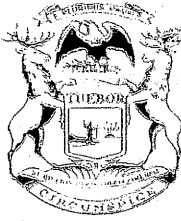

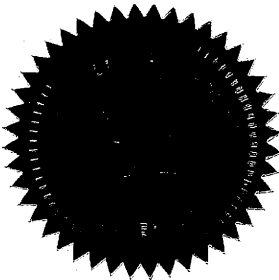
Whereas, Michigan is home to more than 36 ski resorts that are within a two-hour or less drive from anywhere in the state, unlike any other state in the nation; and,


